Camden Lakeside Country Club Membership Categories

COUNTRY MEMBER

Non Member of a Constituent Leagues Club. Open to all Male and Female Members - 7 day play. Not permitted to nominate for election for the Board of Directors.

SUNDAY (6 DAY) MEMBER

Open to all Male and Female Members. Valid Sunday to Friday inclusive. Social play only permitted on Saturday at social green fee rates. Not permitted to nominate for election for the Board of Directors.

MID-WEEK MEMBER

Open to all Male and Female Members. Valid Monday to Friday inclusive. Permitted to play in Competitions on Public Holidays mid-week at visitor rates. Social play only permitted on Weekends at social green fee rates. Not permitted to nominate for election for the Board of Directors or Golf Committee.

COLT MEMBER

Open to all Male and Female Members that are aged between the years of 18 and 20 - 7 day play. Not permitted to nominate for election for the Board of Directors.

JUNIOR MEMBER

Open to all Male and Female Members that are aged between the years of 14 and 17 - 7 day play. Not permitted to nominate for election for the Board of Directors.

CADET MEMBER

Open to all Male and Female Members that are aged between the years of 8 and 13. Please read rules and conditions of Cadet Membership.

Conditions Of Cadet Membership

- Open to Males and Females that are aged between the years of eight (8) and thirteen (13).
- Permitted to participate in the Saturday afternoon Junior Golf Foundation Clinics at the nominated fee set, and payable to the Head Golf Professional.
- Opportunity to participate in the Camden Lakeside Country Club Cadet 9 Hole Golf Competitions played on Saturday afternoons only when the Cadets course etiquette and playing skills are deemed appropriate by the Head Golf Professional, and thereby obtaining a restricted 9 Hole Competition Handicap.

Golf Course Access - For Cadet Members

Will be restricted to the following:

Cadet Members are not entitled to play socially on the Golf Course unless:-

- They play during the New South Wales Gazetted School Holiday period, and
- They are supervised by their guardian, parent or suitable adult (18 years of age) at all times whilst they are on the golf course and surrounds, and
- They book in the Golf Shop prior to play on the nominated days (school holidays) social play.
